The **Heroes for Young Hearts** awards recognize individuals who demonstrate a continuous commitment in their local community to raise awareness of Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) in children and young adults by taking specific actions that support the Parent Heart Watch (PHW) mission of protecting children and young adults from Sudden Cardiac Arrest and preventable Sudden Cardiac Death.

CATEGORIES INCLUDE

ADVOCACY CHAMPION

Medical or Allied Health Professional

ADVOCACY CHAMPION—YOUTH

(must be 20 years of age or younger)

ADVOCACY CHAMPION—ADULT

(must be 21 years of age or older)

YOUNG SURVIVOR CHAMPION

(must be an SCA survivor 25 years of age or younger)

NOMINATION GUIDELINES: Nominations must be submitted for one (1) individual per category and must include specific, measurable examples of the nominee's actions and impact between September 2025 and September 2026 to support the Parent Heart Watch (PHW) mission. Examples may include organizing multiple community heart screenings, placing AEDs in local facilities, conducting research that advances prevention, or leading education and awareness efforts.

Nominations must include supporting materials such as photos and/or link(s) to relevant news article(s). Nominations without specific actions, measurable impact, and supporting materials will not be considered.

AWARDS PRESENTATION: Awards will be presented on Friday, January 15, 2027 at the 22nd Annual National Heart to Heart in Saint Petersburg, Florida.
